Recommendation:

Authorize the Executive Director to Award a contract to SFM Services LLC. in the amount of \$160,008 as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder to IFB #19-02 for the OmniRide Transit Center LED Lighting Phase II Project.

Background:

The Potomac and Rappahannock Transportation Commission (PRTC) has determined through internal and external site safety and security audits that the exterior lighting is inadequate at the OmniRide Transit Center. With concerns for employee and facility safety and security, PRTC has identified a quality replacement LED light fixture that will greatly increase the exterior lighting as well as lowering power consumption and meeting the required footcandles as recommended by the audits.

PRTC authorized a competitive procurement earlier this year and the Invitation for Bids (IFB) was issued on August 3, 2018 with the pre-bid meeting held on August 20, 2018. Four bids were received on September 14, 2018. After the bid opening it was determined that the initial low bidder had proposed an unapproved product. PRTC didn't receive the specifications for the alternate product prior to receiving the bids, therefore management deemed the bid non-responsive¹.

Management is recommending that the contract be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, SFM Services LLC. in the amount of \$160,008 and is seeking budget authorization for a contingency allowance of five (5) percent, or \$8,000, for a total budget of \$168,008.

Fiscal Impact:

Funding for this project is included in PRTC's FY2019 budget and is being provided by state and local funds.

¹ Bidders were given the opportunity to bid a LED light product that wasn't specified in the Scope of Work, if they submitted the specifications for that product three weeks in advance of the bid due dates so that staff could determine if the product met the technical specifications and foot candles of coverage required by the procurement.
