






Northern Virginia Regional Express Lanes Network

- 90+ mile Express Lanes network planned in Northern Virginia
- 81 miles in service
 - I-95, I-395, I-495, I-66 Inside the Beltway, I-66 Outside the Beltway
- 13 miles under construction
 - I-95 to Fredericksburg
 - o I-495 Northern Extension
 - I-95 Express Lanes/Opitz Boulevard Ramp
- 11 miles under study
 - I-495 Southside Express Lanes
- Three independent operators





Transform 66 Outside the Beltway Express Lanes Overview

- \$2.3 billion, 22.5-mile project
- Providing \$3.7 billion in transportation improvements to I-66 corridor
- Project construction began Nov. 2017
- Building 4 express lanes (2 lanes in each direction), alongside 3 general purpose lanes, with space in median for future transit
- Built and opened 2 park and ride lots with 3,200+ parking spaces
- Providing 11 miles of bike trail parallel to I-66, and improved pedestrian facilities on new bridges over I-66
- Public-private partnership with I-66 Express Mobility Partners (EMP) through 2066









66 Express Lanes Are Now Open

- Full 22 miles of 66 Express Lanes opened on Nov. 22 with tolling and HOV rules in effect
- Express Lanes between Route 28 and I-495
 - Opened Nov. 19 (westbound) and Nov. 22 (eastbound)
- Express Lanes between Gainesville and Route 28 in Centreville
 - Opened Sept. 10
 - Tolling and HOV operations began Sept. 24

****Construction activities will continue into 2023****







How 66 Express Lanes Work

- Variable tolls based on traffic volumes and speed to manage demand and keep lanes free flowing
- Three tolling segments eastbound; four tolling segments westbound
- Pricing displayed on signs in advance of all entrances and new segments. A single trip may include more than one toll segment

- Additional payment options offered by I-66 EMP include online at Ride66Express.com, phone at 833-643-2867, in-person at 66 Express Lanes Customer Service Center in Manassas. Payment options other than E-ZPass will incur administrative fees

Eligible High Occupancy Vehicles (HOVs) with 3 or more occupants ride toll-free with E-ZPass Flex in "HOV ON" mode







I-66 Corridor-Wide HOV Travel Change

- HOV requirement switched from 2 to 3 occupants for toll-free Express Lanes travel across I-66 corridor starting Monday, Dec. 5
- New HOV-3+ rule is in effect across entire I-66 corridor Outside the Beltway (24/7) and Inside the Beltway (peak directions, peak periods)





Why HOV-2 to HOV-3 on I-66 Corridor?

- HOV-3 requirement is consistent across entire 90+ Express Lanes network in Northern Virginia region
- Follows regional policy to increase occupancy requirements on all HOV lanes in the region to HOV-3
- Moves more people on I-66 with fewer vehicles
- Supports the public interest by reducing the number of vehicle miles traveled, reducing travel times, increasing speeds in the Express Lanes and general purpose lanes, and complying with the federal Clean Air Act Amendment of 1990
- Is consistent with the National Capital Region's Transportation Planning Board policy since 2010 to increase the occupancy requirements on HOV lanes in the region to HOV-3



Decision Points Leading to Conversion of HOV-2 to HOV-3

Virginia's Commonwealth Transportation Board (CTB) Approvals

June 14, 2016 CTB Resolution:

- Approval for I-66 Outside the Beltway from University Boulevard in Gainesville to I-495 (Capital Beltway)
 - Published notices of intent to change HOV designation and held public hearings on May 23, 24 and 25, 2016
 - Demonstrated that changing HOV designation is in the public interest, and will facilitate the flow of traffic and comply with federal Clean Air Act Amendment of 1990

July 28, 2016 CTB Resolution:

- Approval for **I-66 Inside the Beltway** from I-495 to Route 29 in Rosslyn
- Approval for I-66 Outside the Beltway from Route 15 in Haymarket to University Boulevard in Gainesville

Approved HOV-2 to HOV-3 change to begin after service commencement on 66 Express Lanes Outside the Beltway in late 2022





VDOT 66 Express Lanes Outreach Campaign – "66 Express Lanes: Changing the Way You Move"

- Promote new opportunities and incentives to carpool, vanpool, and ride commuter bus on 66 Express Lanes
- Inform public of change from HOV-2+ to HOV-3+ for tollfree travel on Express Lanes
- Raise awareness of the need for E-ZPass Flex for toll-free HOV travel
- Focus on Express Lanes users across entire I-66 corridor
 - outside and inside the Beltway



Form Your HOV-3+ Carpool Now and Earn Up To \$366 Per Person

The new 166 Express Larves will be free for HOV-34 carpeols when the new 224 miles of larves open between Galaxwelle and I-406 in late 2023. This change from HOV-24 to HOV-34 will also include the carriert I-66 Express Larves inside the Beltway.

VDOT and the region's Commune Connections program have partnered to offer an incentive of up to \$866 per person for new HOV3+ carpools traveling in the LGS contribut. The program is available new and will pay each participant a cash reward following three months of carpooling, regardless of whether they are a driver or passenge





Promoting Express Lanes Use by HOV, Bus, and Vanpool

- 66 Express Lanes will provide faster and more reliable toll-free travel for carpools, vanpools, and commuter buses
- Fairfax Connector bus expanding routes beginning January 2023
- VDOT and Department of Rail and Public Transportation offering discounts and assistance for new vanpools
- VDOT and Commuter Connections offering \$366 per person incentive for new HOV-3+ carpools using 66 Express Lanes Outside the Beltway
 - Up to \$366 per person after 90 days
 - Program available now
