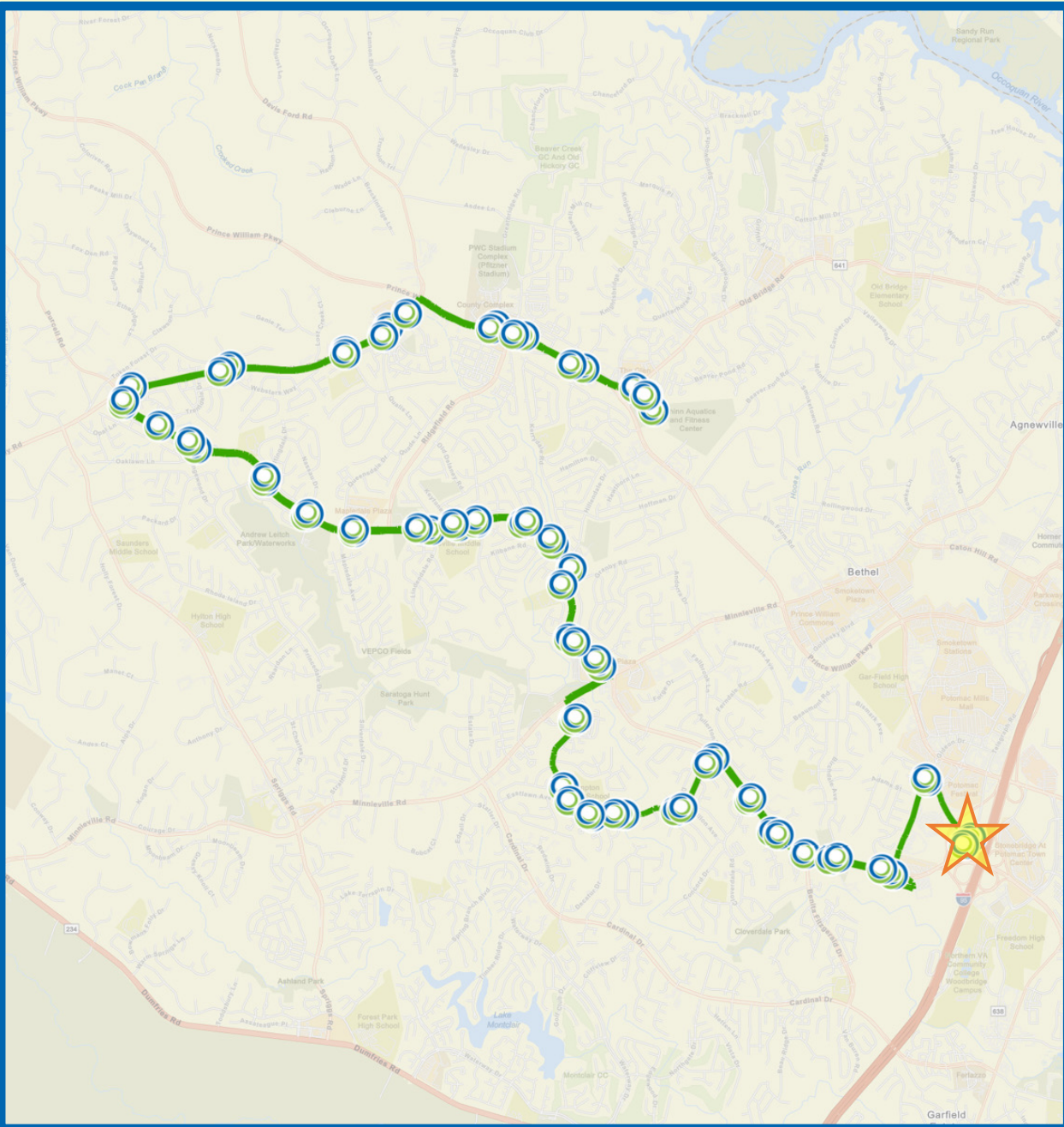

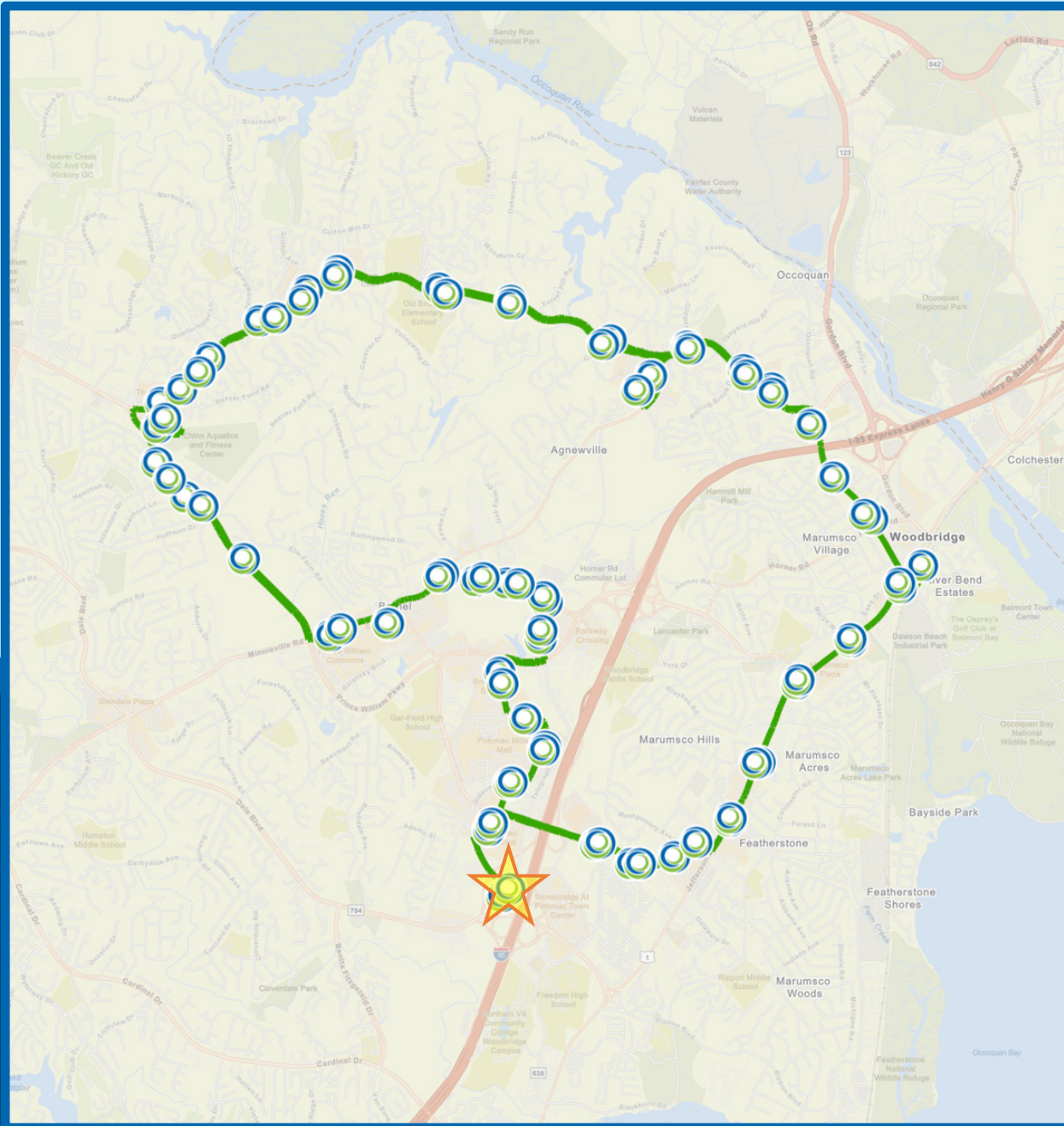
Operating Characteristics

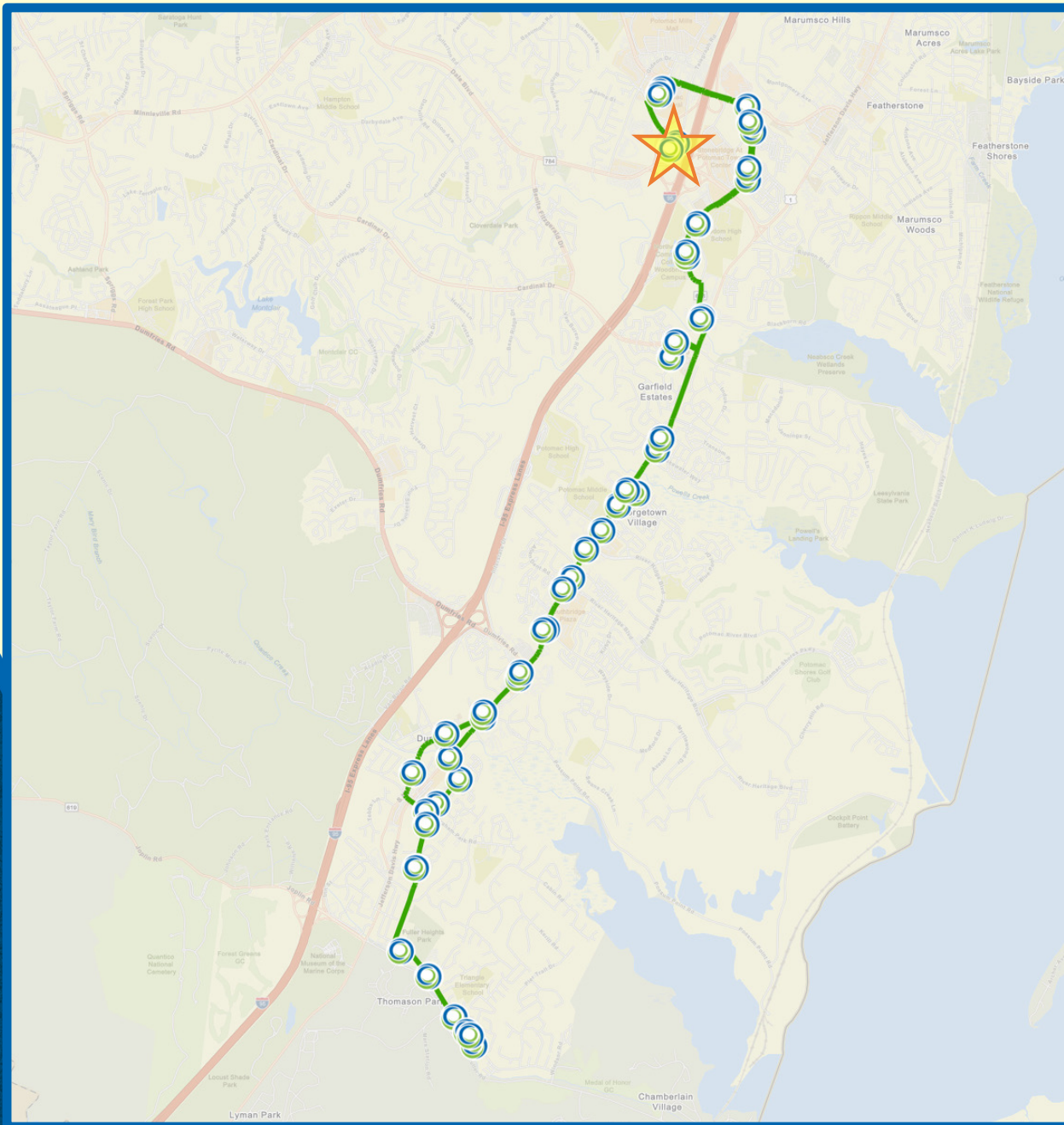

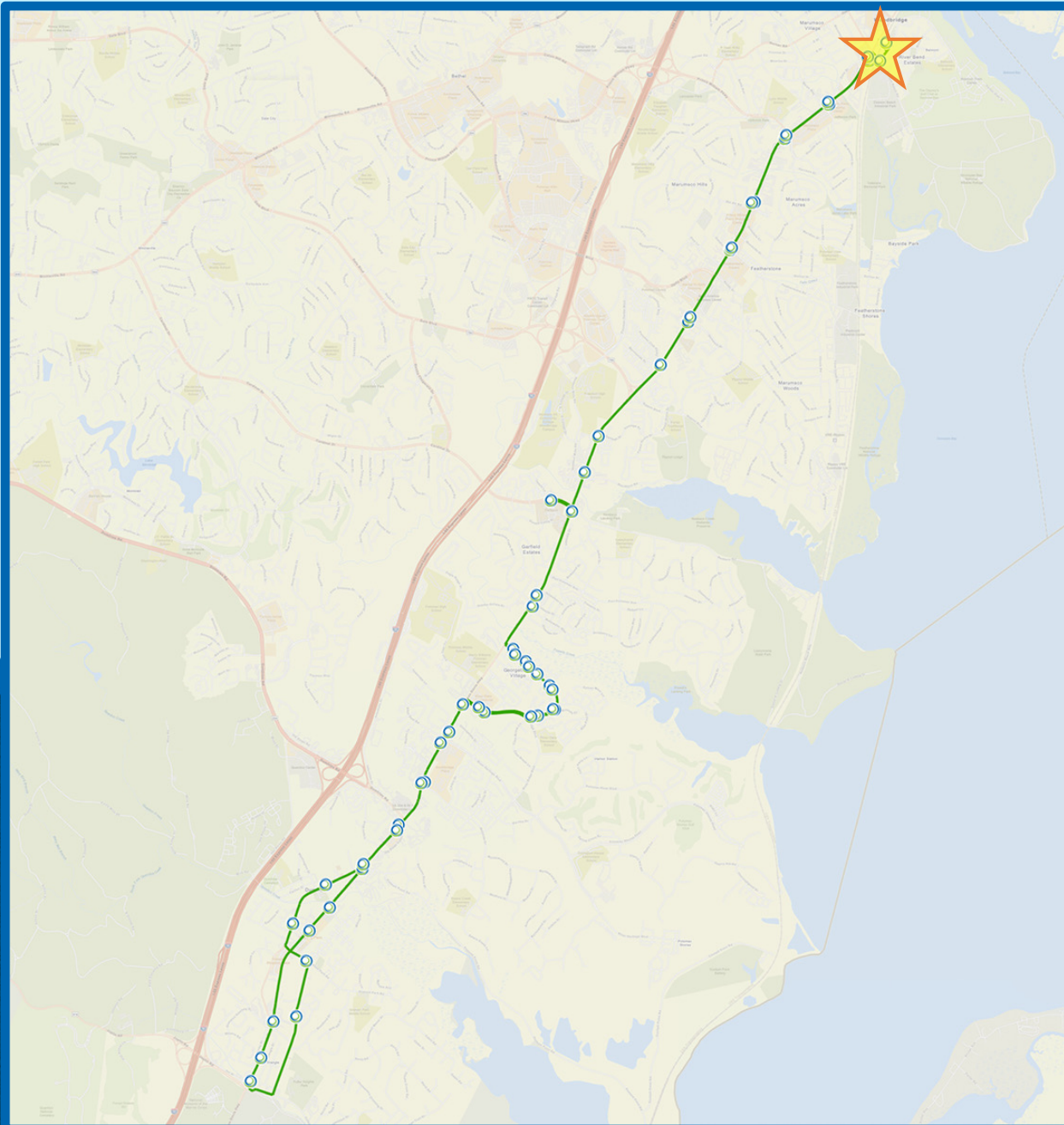

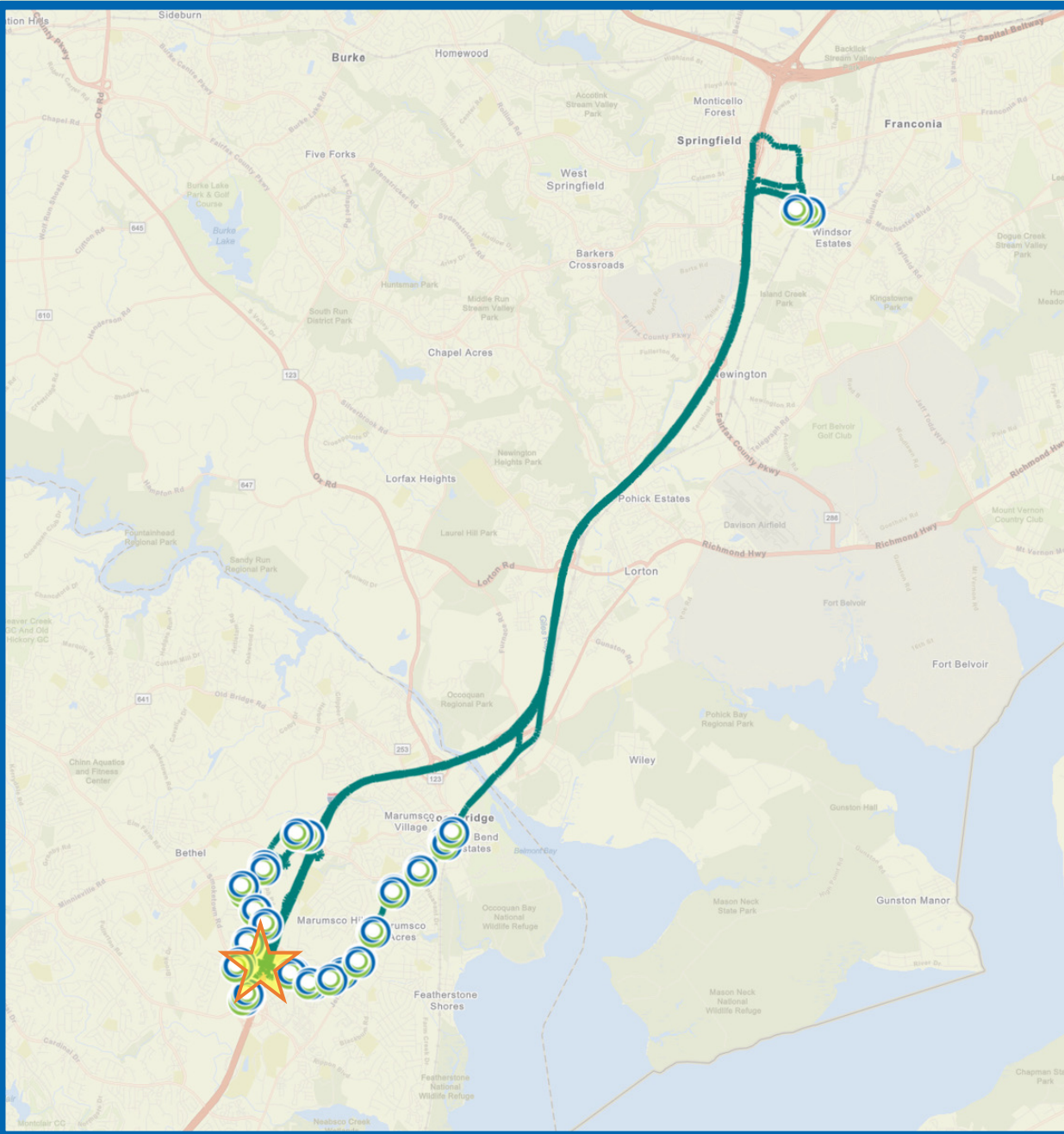

Microtransit in Manassas Park / Downtown Manassas

What is OmniRide Connect?

- On-demand rideshare service, offering trips within a Manassas Park defined service area
- Allows passengers to request trips on demand, rather than hours or days beforehand
- Short local trips and uses small vehicles
- Safe, reliable and convenient option to connect to OmniRide Local bus routes
- Allows for Electronic Payment
- Provides for the ability for users to manage personal information, payment method, ride history, request rides and provide feedback on the service
- Provides real-time information related to vehicle location before and during the trip

Service Information

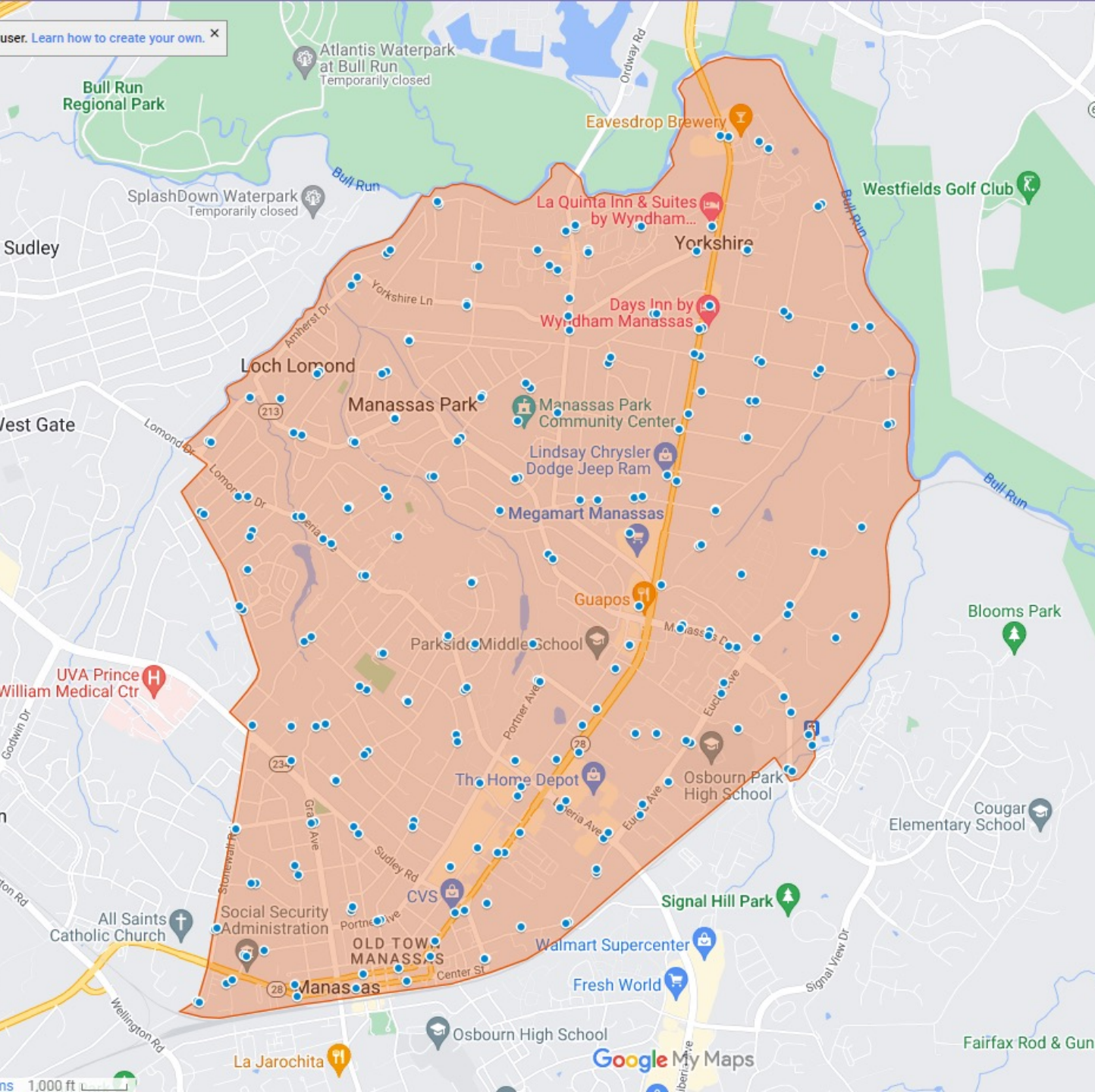
- Monday – Friday, 6:00 am until 8:00 pm
- No fares currently
- When fares return to local fixed route, each OmniRide Connect trip will cost \$2.00
- Only Same Day trips permitted within OmniRide Connect Zone
- Wait time for service is intended to be no more than 15 minutes from time of reservation to time of pickup



Corner-to-Corner Service

Transportation service that directs passengers to a nearby pickup point and drops them off at a point close to their destination.

Vehicles are routed using a proprietary algorithm that determines the most efficient path to the requested pickup and drop off locations, with the ability to optimize for multiple parameters (eg. Traffic, new passengers, construction).



Manassas Park Microtransit Zone

- This map depicts all approved microtransit stops within the polygon
- All stops are within $\frac{1}{4}$ mile walking distance from each other

Other Services Provided by OmniRide



- PRTC's On-The-Go Travel Training Program is designed to help potential riders get over the hurdle of the unfamiliar and become confident users of public transportation.
- This free program provides:
 - One-on-one or group training opportunities for individuals who want to learn how to ride or gain confidence using public transportation.
 - Train-the-trainer opportunities for clinicians and others who will be providing information and travel training services to others.

Wheels to Wellness

What is Wheels-to-Wellness?

Wheels-to-Wellness provides travel assistance that eligible residents can use to access health services. Service provided by Yellow Cab and NoVA Checker Cab

Who is Eligible?

To qualify, applicants must be:

- 80 years old or older (age requirement may be lowered); OR
 - Disabled as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act;
AND/OR
 - Have income that is no greater than 1.9 times the federal poverty level and NOT BE eligible for Medicaid transportation services
-
- In addition, the applicant must reside in Prince William County, Manassas City, or Manassas Park City, although trips do not have to begin or end in those areas.

Where can I go with a Wheels-to-Wellness payment card?

Health related trips include visits to:

- Hospitals
 - Urgent care facilities
 - Doctor's offices
 - Nurse practitioners
 - Therapists
 - Pharmacies including locations in full service stores
 - Dialysis centers
 - Medical laboratories
 - Rehabilitation facilities
 - Medical supply stores and other medical establishments
