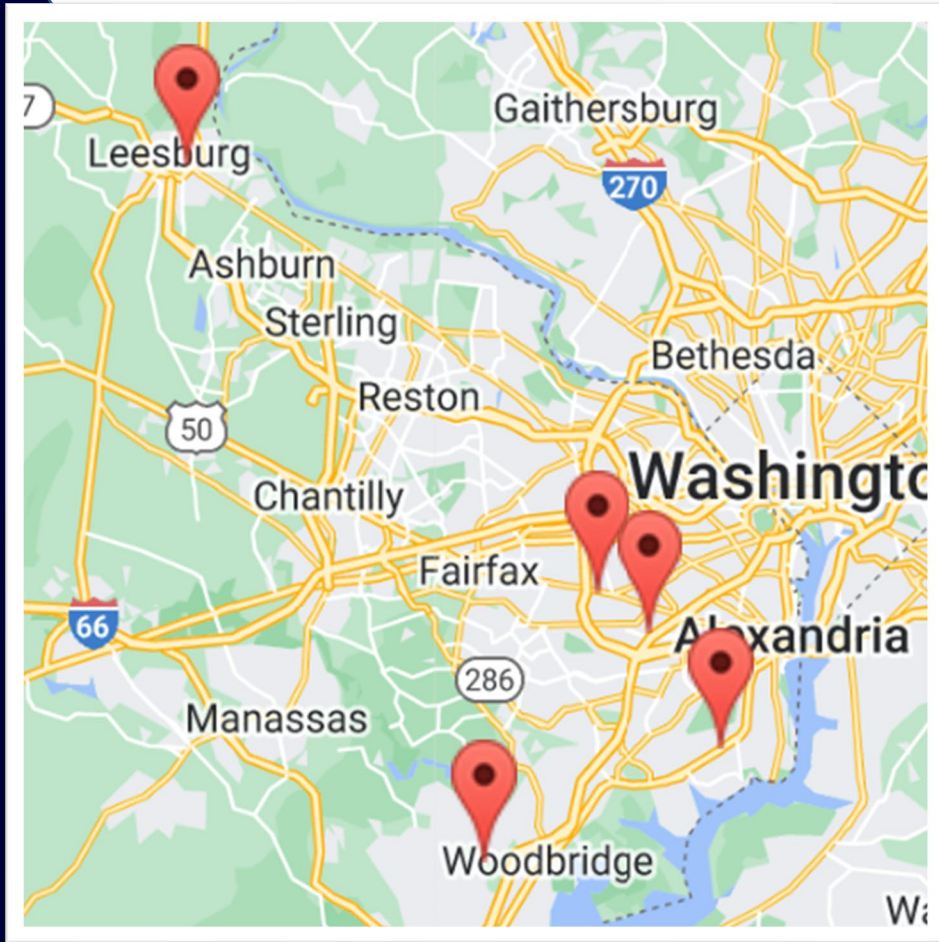

ELEVATE



ELEVATE assists Prince William County jobseekers and employers impacted by COVID-19. Jobseekers receive assistance with career coaching, skills training, and work-experience opportunities. Employers receive assistance to hire and train employees through the coordination of job fairs and hiring events, on-the-job training funds, and incumbent worker training reimbursement. ELEVATE ends October 31st, 2024.

Paid Work Experience



- ✓ Develop the future workforce by providing on-site training opportunities at no cost to the employer
- ✓ Help job seekers learn new skills and gain experience

On-the-Job Training



- ✓ Up to \$5,000 is available per new hire to offset the costs of training a new employee
- ✓ Receive reimbursement for percentage of wages paid to eligible new hires

Incumbent Worker Training



- ✓ Re-train and upskill existing employees to develop skills and earn credentials through Incumbent Worker Training opportunities
- ✓ Upskilled workforce makes the employer more competitive and profitable

Job Fairs and Hiring Events



- ✓ Receive assistance in set-up, job seeker outreach, and day-of support to fill employer needs
- ✓ Multi-employer job fairs are coordinated quarterly
- ✓ Targeted events are coordinated at employer request
- ✓ Virtual events available through Premier Virtual online platform
